About Nebraska's Lawyer Discipline System:

Ranked 28th in the nation overall.

↓ Under Nebraska's "gag rule," consumers who do not keep grievances confidential will be subject to discipline.

↓ The Nebraska Counsel for Discipline is one of only six disciplinary agencies that does not distribute a brochure to individuals who have questions about the lawyer discipline system.

↑ Accommodating and informative, the staff responding to telephone inquiries at the Nebraska Counsel for Discipline provides direct answers to consumers and allows grievances to be filed over the telephone if the complaining party is unable to submit a grievance in writing.

↓ The Counsel for Discipline will not inform inquiring consumers about whether a complaint was ever filed against their attorney. Instead, the office will only provide information about whether the attorney has been publicly disciplined.
